### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. BALTICA RIDERS TOUR is a Series of competitions organized by Stowarzyszenie Kultury Fizycznej Stadnina Koni Ciekocinko, located in Ciekocinko 9, 84-210 Choczewo Poland.
- 2. All competitions of BALTICA RIDERS TOUR will take place during Baltica Spring Tour & Baltica Summer Tour 2017 organized by Stowarzyszenie Kultury Fizycznej Stadnina Koni Ciekocinko.
- BALTICA RIDERS TOUR is open for competitors of all the nations. Rules allowing competitors to participate in the Series are according to the FEI Rules and FEI Official Schedules of Baltica Spring Tour & Baltica Summer Tour 2017. All information about the Series and current rankings is available at www.balticatour.com
- 4. The BALTICA RIDERS TOUR Spring Edition starts on May 16<sup>th</sup> and finish on June 4<sup>th</sup>, the Summer Edition starts on August 15<sup>th</sup> and finish on September 3<sup>rd</sup>. The final results of the series will be announced on September 3<sup>rd</sup> 2017.
- 5. BALTICA RIDERS TOUR contains six competitions five qualifiers and one final competition. All competitions are according to the FEI Official Schedules of Baltica Spring Tour & Baltica Summer Tour 2017. All qualifiers are independent participation in one of the classifications does not exclude participation in others.
- 6. In the BALTICA RIDERS TOUR, the following competitions will be provided as part of the Series:

IMPORTANT: Please note that Riders are not obliged to take part in every classifying class. Riders may earn points in all of the competitions counting for the Baltica Riders Tour, but only their four best results count for the final classification.

### **CLASSIFICATION RULES & PRIZES**

- BALTICA RIDERS TOUR comprises 6 weeks of CSI2\*/3\* with 6 competitions listed in point 6. In the final competition points will be doubled. Winner over the 6 weeks Series will be the Rider having earned the most points based on his four best results.
- 2. In each qualifier and in the final competition the Riders will receive points as follows:

- 3. The position in the final classification is determined on the basis of the sum total of ranking points of each Rider's four best results. In the event that Riders accumulate the same number of ranking points, their qualifying place is determined by the Rider rank in the Final.
- 4. In the BALTICA RIDERS TOUR classification, top three Riders who have accumulated the highest number of ranking points based on their four best results receive financial prizes in the following amounts:

1 <sup>st</sup> place:	2 <sup>nd</sup> place:	3 <sup>rd</sup> place:	Total prize:

<sup>\*</sup> From the prizes the OC will deduct a 10% tax on the value of the prize.

5. The prizes will be transferred to the bank account indicated by the winners within 30 days from the announcement of the Series results. The winners are obliged to provide the OC with their bank account details.
